Career opportunities

The Master delivers **high level education** in public health issues. It provides students with the methods, analytical tools and conceptual knowledge required to take on responsibilities in public health as decision makers.

The professional opportunities vary according to the specialisations in the Master. These Masters specialisations lead to a **wide range of career openings** such as:

- management of social and healthcare institutions,
- implementation and assessment of public health policies,
- management of health promotion and prevention programmes,
- management and assessment of environmental health risks,
- audit and consulting,
- education and research.

The Master meets **identified public health needs** in many different sectors, for example:

- national public administrations,
- state services,
- local authorities,
- public and private hospitals,
- associations, private companies and organisations,
- European and international bodies.

Study programme

EUROPUBHEALTH is a two year Masters course equivalent to 120 ECTS Credits (European Credit Transfer System).

The first year concerns the foundations of public health and takes place either in Sheffield (in English) or in Granada (in Spanish). The second year of specialisation is held in a different country. Two modules bring together all EUROPUBHEALTH students in Rennes (France) at the end of the first year (4 weeks) and at the end of the second year (2 weeks).

Students

EUROPUBHEALTH course is a Masters degree for professionals and students from all around the world. For admission to the Masters course, students require a minimum of a Bachelors degree in: economics, law, management, political science, life sciences, health, nursing sciences, social sciences, physical science....

Languages

Students should be proficient in the languages of the choosen pathway:

- English
- English + French
- Spanish + English
- Spanish + French + English

Teaching staff

Around 70 teachers from the 6 consortium partners provide tuition for the European Masters course and oversee the students.

The teaching staff includes university lecturers as well as professionals who are active in the public health sector (doctors, nurses, managers of care establishments, health engineers, health inspectors, pharmacists, administrators, etc.).



● Double diploma

On successful completion of the EUROPUBHEALTH Masters course (120 ECTS), students are awarded a double diploma. This comprises the two national diplomas awarded by:

- the University of Sheffield or EASP of Granada;
- the institution in which the student undertakes his specialisation.

● Admission requirements

The criteria for eligibility are:

- a university Bachelor degree, i.e. 180 ECTS,
- proficiency in the languages suitable for the combination chosen and the languages of instruction,
- submission before the deadline of a full application, together with all the necessary supporting documents.

Registration and tuition fees: 12 150 € for the two years of study.
